AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROPESVILLE, TEXAS, REINSTATING A PORTION OF THE MAP, PLAT AND DEDICATION OF THE CITY OF ROPESVILLE, FILED BY THOMAS C. SPEARMAN, JUNE 22, 1918, RECORDED IN VOL 6, PAGE 492, OF THE DEED RECORDS OF HOCKLEY COUNTY, TEXAS

A request having been duly filed with the City Council of the City of Ropesville, Texas, praying that portions of the plat dedication of the City of Ropesville, executed and filed by Thomas C. Spearman on June 22, 1918, and recorded in Vol. 6, Page 492 of the Deed Records of Hockley County, Texas, be reinstated and returned to the lots, blocks, streets and alleys in said plat and are contained in the following particular description, to wit:

All of Lots One through Twenty-four (1-24), Block Twenty-seven (27) of the Original Town of Ropesville, Hockley County, Texas, and the streets surrounding said Block Twenty-seven (27).

and the City Council of the City of Ropesville, Texas, having received said request and having given due notice thereof, and having heard the same on the 13th day of September, 2016, and there being no objection or protest thereto, and the City Council of the City of Ropesville, Texas being of the opinion that said request should be granted;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Ropesville, Texas, that the portion of the Plat and Dedication of the City of Ropesville, Texas, as contained in the metes and bounds description in Volume 43, Page 481, of the Deed Records of Hockley County, Texas, and being Lot 1-24, Block 27 of the City of Ropesville, Hockley County, Texas, be and the same is hereby reinstated, and the lots, blocks, and alleys lying within the boundaries of said Block Twenty-seven (27) and the streets around said Block shall be and are hereby returned to their original description as originally platted and recorded in Volume 6, Page 492 of the Deed Records of Hockley County, Texas, and that the previous revocation of said Lots 1-24, Block 27, as described by metes and bounds in Volume 43, Page 481, shall from and after this date be held for naught for all purposes and it is further ordered that this ordinance and order be entered in the minutes of the City Council of the City of Ropesville, and that the Clerk shall certify a copy thereof to be recorded in the Deed Records of Hockley County, Texas.
