

RESOLUTION No. 2017 05 - 1

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTING AND APPROVING, AND SUPPORTIVE OF ALL THE ORDINANCES THAT ARE IN THE ORDINANCE BOOK AS TRUE AND EXISTING EVEN THOUGH SOME ORDINANCE ARE COPIES OF THE ORIGINAL ORDINANCES; AND THESE ORDINANCES SHALL BE USED BY THE CITY; WITH A BEGINNING EFFECTIVE DATE OF MAY 1, 2017 FOR ALL ORDINANCE THAT EXIST AND ARE INCLUDING IN THE ORDINANCE BOOK; THAT AS STATED BY LAW IN THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE CHAPTER 53, SECTION 53.005. A COPY OF THE ORDINANCES ARE AUTHENTIC AND MAY BE USED TO ENFORCE EACH RULE, ORDINANCE OR POLICE REGULATION OF THE CITY OF ROPESVILLE AND THE COURT MAY PUNISH A VIOLATION OF THE RULES, ORDINANCE AND OR POLICE REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, Chapter 53, Code of Ordinances, Section 53.006 Printed Code as Evidence, In the Texas Local Government Code, stating that under the direction of the governing body of the municipality a copy of the Ordinance that is authenticated and approved by the mayor's signature and attested by the secretary of the municipality, in court be evidence of the existence and enactment of the ordinance that were adopted, and

WHEREAS, the City of Ropesville desires to demonstrate that all Ordinances in the Ordinance book have been approved by a sitting council, for the City of Ropesville; and can back-up the Ordinances with the minutes as passed and approved and signed by the Mayor, and

WHEREAS, the City of Ropesville Aldermen has noted that during a storm, damaged was well-known to the Public that City Office received damage, and some of the Original Ordinance, and records were destroyed, and

WHEREAS, the City Aldermen have noted that copies of the Ordinance are still in existence will adopt and approve these ordinances to be effective for use by the City of Ropesville and Ropesville Municipal Court, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ROPESVILLE:

SECTION 1.

That all Ordinances have been reviewed that remain in the Ordinance book as of May 9th, 2017

SECTION 2. Code of Municipal Ordinances

1. That the Ordinances shall be valid until amended, codified, repeal, or replaced.
2. That all the existing Ordinance be numbered and be filed with a file number.


3. That all Ordinance that pertain to Franchise Agreement be placed in its individual-distinct Ordinance book. (giving reference to the Agreement updated in the Municipal Ordinance books.)
4. That all up dated Ordinances:
 - A. that have been amended, codified, repealed or replaced be kept in a Book so called and numbered as amended, codified repeal or replaced. (Texas Local Government Code Chapter 53 Section 53.004)


Section 3. General Provisions

1. The governing body of the City of Ropesville may enforced each rule, ordinance or police regulation of the municipality and may punish a violation of a rules, ordinance or police regulation.
2. A fine or penalty for each violation of a rule, ordinance, or police regulation may not exceed \$500.00 dollars unless it is a fine or penalty for the violation of a rules, ordinance, or police regulation that governing fire safety, zoning or public health and sanitation including dumping or refuse and this fine may not exceed \$2000.00 dollars. (Texas Government Code, Chapter 54, subchapter A Section 54.001 (a) and (b) General Enforcement, Authority of Municipalities; Penalty.)

Such shall not affect the validity of the remainder of these ordinances, which in remainder shall continue in effect this the 9th day of May 2017
