

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-0912-8 File No. _____

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A NEW POLICY AND PROCEDURE OF THE CIVIL AND CRIMINAL ODEINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROPESVILLE, PROVIDING THE PRINTING THEREOF AUTHENTICATION BY THE MAYOR AND ATTESTATION BY THE CITY SECRETARY; PROVIDING THAT SAID ORDINANCE MAY BE ADMITTED IN EVIDENCE WITHOUT NECESSAITY OF OTHER PROOF OF AMENDMENTS TO SAID ORDINANCE; PROVIDING A FINE AND A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED \$2,000.00 FOR VIOLATION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES PERTAINING TO FIRE SAFETY ZONING, OR PUBLIC HEALTH AND SANITATION, INCLUDING OF REFUESE, FOLLOWING THE CULPABLE MENTAL STATE LAW FOR THE STATE OF TEXAS; AND A FINE OR PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED \$500.00 FOR VIOLATIONS OF CERTAIN CASES OF THE ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF SAID ORDINANCE.

BE IR ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF ROPESVILLE

WHEREAS, This Ordinance for the City of Ropesville, provided: that, the City Council may adopt any ordinance or codification of ordinances or parts thereof, and may amend and correct certain ordinances therein for general distribution; and

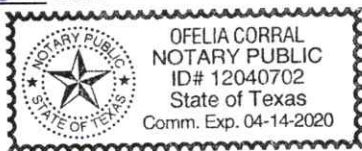
